



# **Early Contractor Involvement**

- Considered use of PSC, Option E or use of Sections
- Bespoke Early Conditional Appointment adopted (processes for design, supply chain pricing, joint risk management, early activities on site and preconditions to start on site)

# Price and timetable certainty

- Shared savings under Option A
- Agreed forms of Pre-construction Timetable, Risk Register and a Pre-Construction Agreement











# NEC3 or PPC2000?



- Use of Framework Agreement for boilerplate clauses on Security, Freedom of Information etc
- Minimum Z clauses and Special Terms
- Bidders priced both PPC2000 and NEC3 for Alliance reprocurement
- Further MoJ option to select PPC2000 or NEC3 or require both to be priced under:
  - Call-off or Mini-competition
- Assessment of costs and project performance incurred in procuring/running projects under PPC2000 and NEC3
- Cabinet Office benchmarking through Pilot projects













# **New Models of Construction Procurement**

- Early Contractor Involvement main route used by the MoJ
- Cost lead procurement used on one project
- Integrated Project Insurance unlikely to be used
